Directions to Great Conewago Presbyterian Church

174 Red Bridge Rd., Gettysburg, PA 17325

From Port Royal: Take Rts. 11/15S to Harrisburg following Rt. 15S turn (right lane and sharp, look for signs) to Rt. 15S.* Stay on 15S to Hunterstown exit. At ramp end turn left. Travel about 2 miles and turn left on Red Bridge Road. (Small church sign, black and white at corner). Church will be seen on a hill to your left.

From Harrisburg & Lebanon: Take 581 to Gettysburg/Camp Hill exit and follow 15S. Then follow from above.*

From Carlisle: Take Rt. 34S. to Rt. 94 S. Follow 94S to Route 15 and go South and Follow directions from above.*

From Chambersburg: Take Rt. 30E to 15N. At Hunterstown take ramp and turn right. Go about 2 miles to the intersection. Turn left on Red Bridge Rd. Church on the left.
