Mission Trip Details

Each one-week trip costs \$1,000 per volunteer. This fee includes:

- Transportation from Harrisburg to departure airport.
- Airfare from departure airport to Port-au-Prince and return.
- Secure transportation from Port-au-Prince airport to site and return.
- Secure room and board (very basic accommodations) with safe water.
- Materials and supplies needed to perform the assignment.

In many cases this fee also supports hiring Haitians to work alongside you. This creates a deeper sense of partnership and provides badly needed employment for Haitians.

The Tragedy in Haiti

The devastating earthquake of January, 2010, forcefully brought the plight of the people of Haiti to the attention of all Americans.

Approximately 230,000 people were killed. Almost 100,000 suffered some form of amputation (from fingers and toes to whole limbs). An estimated one million people were forced into temporary tent cities and as many as 25,000 “unaccompanied children” may eventually be classified as orphans.

International aid agencies have responded heroically to the immediate needs. The long-term recovery of Haiti will depend on the Haitian people. Won't you help them get back on their feet?

The Pennsylvania Ecumenical Response
